We will aim to prevent the military equipment from being moved into the Excel Centre and there will also be safe, fun and family-friendly activities, including a Mad Hatters Tea Party.

There will also be a presence from Arms to Renewables.

As well as people on the front line, we need people to fulfil support roles – including legal observers, drivers, and social media work. Please let us know if you can fulfil these roles.

The world's biggest arms company, Lockheed Martin, plays a key role in the UK's nuclear weapons. The missiles are manufactured by Lockheed, and the company jointly manages the bases at Aldemaston and Burghfield (with Jacobs and Serco), where the warheads are designed, manufactured and refurbished.

Another huge arms company, Rolls Royce, manufactures the nuclear fuel rods used in the reactors at their plant in Derby. The involvement of these companies in the UK nuclear deterrent allows them a huge amount of influence over the Government, which in turn seeks to secure lucrative export deals for them.
