



"I wish to speak"



Direct Reply. (If you want to make a direct reply to the current speaker you can use this to jump the cue — by the time it was your turn the discussion will probably have moved on. Should only be used when necessary)



Technical Point. (A **short** point of **information** that needs to go in at this point, e.g. "The bus actually leaves at 8, not at 9". The facilitator will usually interrupt the current speaker to allow you to say this. A technical point should **never** be an opinion and should only be used when strictly necessary.)



"I agree/Good idea" (This is a really useful signal which can save hours of repetitive agreement if used frequently.)



"Move on" (If you think the discussion is going round in circles and that consensus has been reached.)



"Speak up" (if you can't hear)



Block. ("I can't accept that" The discussion would then restart from the basis of your objections. Almost never used.)



"I'm confused"



Language. (Request for a translation)
