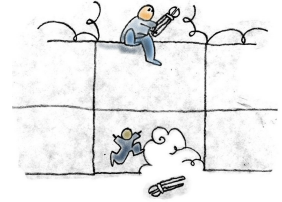




# RESIST, PROTEST, DISRUPT JUNE MONTH OF ACTION AWE BURGHEFIELD

Trident Ploughshares is facilitating many different groups to go in June to AWE Burghfield and engage in nonviolent civil resistance. AWE Burghfield is where nuclear warheads are assembled and maintained and from where they are sent to the Trident submarine bases in Scotland. The site is owned by the Ministry of Defence (MoD) but operation and management of the site is contracted out to AWE Management Ltd, a consortium of Serco, Jacobs Engineering, and Lockheed Martin.

A major programme of construction work is under way at AWE Burghfield to ensure it remains able to manufacture nuclear weapons for the long term future, and will be able to design and develop a new UK Trident warhead. For instance, 'Project Mensa' is a £734 million scheme to build a new warhead assembly / disassembly facility. This is a serious breach of the Non-Proliferation Treaty and undermines international efforts for global nuclear disarmament.
