Thank you for your letter dated 21 October 2021.


I am delighted to confirm that Babcock is fully committed to playing its part in addressing the Global Climate Crisis. This is not just important to me personally, it is important to our employees, to our customers, to the communities in which we work and indeed to all our stakeholders.

In May 2021, we launched Plan Zero 40, our commitment to transition Babcock to a net zero emissions organisation across all of our estate, assets and operations by 2040. We have also signed up to the Business Ambition for 1.5°C Pledge to limit global warming in line with the Paris Agreement and recently published our Carbon Reduction plan. I can assure you we did not make these pledges lightly.
